EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK:

46-20 Wasilow: That the Rural Municipality of Piapot No. 110 council amends the Employee Handbook to:

**15. ACCIDENTS**

15.01 Every accident or incident, no matter how slight it may be, must be reported to the Council, Foreman or Administrator immediately. An employee must stay at the scene of the accident or incident until an investigation has begun or until cleared by the Foreman or Administrator; unless medical attention is required. Failure to report an accident or incident will result in the employee being written up. Failure to report an accident or incident may delay or jeopardize a claim for Workers Compensation. Attempts made to cover-up or help a co-worker cover-up an accident or incident will lead to the immediate dismissal of the employee.

17.04 Reasons for immediate discharge are:

- a) Fighting on Municipal property or on job sites.
- b) Theft of Municipal property or property of a fellow employee.
- c) Willful damage of Municipal property or property of a fellow employee.
- d) Reckless disregard of safety rules.
- e) Arriving at work under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- f) Consuming alcohol or illegal drugs while at work.
- g) Using municipal equipment without permission from Council.
- h) Not being able to maintain a valid driver's license.
- i) Attempts made to cover-up or help a co-worker cover-up an accident or incident.
