**Beaver Bounty Policy**

## **1.0 PURPOSE:**

1.1 The purpose of this policy is to establish a bounty on beavers within the municipality, and establish a price paid to trappers for their catch, to maintain the integrity of roads, culverts, and waterways within the Rural Municipality of Piapot No. 110.

## **2.0 RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 2.1 Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) is responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy.
- 2.2 Council shall review this policy once per year, unless changes are deemed necessary sooner.

## **3.0 IMPLEMENTATION-PROCEDURE**

- 3.1 The municipality shall initiate a bounty on beavers each year;
- 3.2 A bounty of \$15.00 per beaver to a maximum of ten beavers shall be paid; per annum; per owner/lessee of property within the municipality;
- 3.3 Beaver catches must be verified by the division councillor or RM staff;
- 3.4 When the trapper is not the land owner/lessee, the municipality will pay \$15.00 per beaver only when \$10.00 per beaver has been paid and verified by the owner, to the trapper;
- 3.5 When the landowner is not participating in the beaver program, a picture with a date and time stamp of the dead beaver must be provided as proof, prior to compensation being paid.
