Noxious Weed Control

1.0 PURPOSE:

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to establish a method of controlling noxious weeds within the Rural Municipality of Piapot No. 110.

2.0 RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 2.1 Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) is responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy.
- 2.2 Council shall review this policy once per year, unless changes are deemed necessary sooner.

3.0 IMPLEMENTATION-PROCEDURE

- 3.1 The municipality shall cover the entire cost of noxious weed treatment and eradication on developed road allowances and land leased by the municipality;
- 3.2 The municipality will pay 50% of the cost for noxious weed treatment and eradication on private land, where the municipality shall pay the pesticide company in full, and invoice the property owner 50% of the total invoice minus GST.
- 3.3 When notice of noxious weeds is delivered after the weed spraying company has completed spraying for the current year, the type of weed detected, and its location, will be recorded and added to a list to be treated in the next spraying season. If council determines that it would be detrimental to wait until the next year, an attempt will be made to have the spray company return as soon as possible.
