Water Lines Crossing Road Allowance Policy

1.0 PURPOSE:

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to establish a method in which water line installation on road allowances is approved, and completed as to maintain the integrity of road structures.

2.0 RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 2.1 Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) is responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy.
- 2.2 Council shall review this policy once per year, unless changes are deemed necessary sooner.
- 2.3 Council is responsible for approving all requests and applications for installation of water lines through developed and undeveloped road allowances.

3.0 IMPLEMENTATION-PROCEDURE

- 3.1 All line installations must have council approval prior to commencing;
- 3.2 Water lines crossing developed or undeveloped road allowances and field access roads shall be the responsibility of the person or persons completing the installation of the water lines;
- 3.3 On developed road allowances, the line(s) shall be bored through the road and located below the ditch bottom;
- 3.4 On undeveloped road allowances or field access roads, the lines may be ploughed.
- 3.5 The owner of the line shall save harmless and keep indemnified the Rural Municipality of Piapot No. 110 from and against all costs, loss and damage, expense for any cause or reason in respect to works performed.
