Based on \$1.00 per litre municipal costs for diesel fuel and based on a 20 cubic yard payload at \$0.36 per yard per mile, where fuel cost would equal 25% of hauling costs. Should fuel prices increase above the base price, compensation will be adjusted by the percentage increase times percentage of hauling costs. Fuel prices will be reviewed monthly and compensation adjusted.
