RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PIAPOT NO. 110

BYLAW NO. 2015-01

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE DUMPING OF WASTE ON PROPERTY UNDER THE OWNERSHIP OR CONTROL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PIAPOT NO. 110 PURSUANT TO SECTION 8(2)(E) OF THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Piapot No. 110, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. That this bylaw may be cited as the "Litter Control Bylaw".
- **2.** For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Piapot No. 110
 - **b.** "Waste" means any discarded or abandoned organic or inorganic material, including material or by-products discarded in a manufacturing or producing process; snow; ice; dirt; rocks; rubble; garbage; tree cuttings; grass; leaves; empty or partially empty tins, boxes, cartons, bottles and containers; discarded paper, plastic and fabrics; discarded household utensils; household furniture; household appliances of any nature; trees; concrete; slime; tailings; or any other refuse, rubble or matter.
 - **c.** "Dumping" means abandoning waste or causing waste to be abandoned in any location other than in a receptacle provided for the collection of waste, as approved under the authority of *The Litter Control Act*.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 3(1) of *The Litter Control Act*, dumping waste within the Municipality is prohibited and any person found guilty of this offence shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided pursuant to Section 4 of *The Litter Control Act*.
- 4. In addition to any penalty assessed, a person convicted of an offence pursuant to this bylaw shall also be responsible for the cost incurred by the Municipality for waste disposal and clean-up at an hourly rate and:
 - a. The charge shall not be less than a two hour minimum.
 - b. The hourly rate shall be \$100.00 per hour.
 - c. Pursuant to Section 369(2) of *The Municipalities Act*, any unpaid costs incurred by the Municipality that are in arrears as of December 31 shall be added to the tax roll of any parcel of land for which the person is the assessed person convicted of an offence pursuant to this bylaw.

5. Effective Date:

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of its passing.
